

Fire Lieutenant

Nature of Work

Supervisory and technical work on directing the activities of a single engine, squad, ladder, or rescue company.

Responsibility for directing the activities of personnel, and the effective and efficient operation at scenes, including EMS calls, fires, and hazmat operations.

Responsibility for assisting the station Captain for coordinating proper maintenance and operation of the station and equipment. The Station Lieutenant has responsibility (second to that of his or her Station Captain) over personnel and insures that all departmental policies, rules and regulations are followed. Directs and participates in maintenance and cleaning of the station, equipment and apparatus; inspects personnel and maintains discipline; prepares or directs the preparation and maintenance of all necessary records and reports.

Participation in activities as directed by Chief Officers, including attendance at monthly officer and department meetings and training activities.

Minimum Qualifications

Three (3) years firefighting experience.

Ability to work with the District's chief officers, company officers, firefighters, and other employees.

Knowledge of, and ability to comply with, NFPA 1021, "Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications", Fire Officer 1 (Chapter 2), including the following areas:

1. Human Resource Management
2. Community and Government Relations
3. Administration
4. Inspection and Investigation
5. Emergency Service Delivery

Knowledge of the District's policies and procedures and general firefighting principles.

Past participation in District activities.
